### FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 116


The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 116 will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, August 5, 2025, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Trinity Room, Houston, Texas\*, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Comments from the public.
2. CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
  - a. Approve minutes.
  - b. Development in the District.
  - c. Garbage collection and recycling matters.
  - d. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
  - e. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
  - f. Operations report from City of Richmond for regional wastewater treatment plant.
  - g. TCEQ Phase II Small MS4 General Permit, including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.
  - h. Coordination with homeowner associations regarding District business, including approve maintenance agreements.
  - i. Reports from Directors and consultants on District matters.
3. NON-CONSENT AGENDA
  - a. Items removed from Consent Agenda.
  - b. Request for District contribution towards the cost of streetlights along Sansbury Boulevard and take appropriate action, including approve letter agreement for same.
  - c. Additional financial and bookkeeping matters.
  - d. Additional tax assessment and collection matters, including:
    - i. discuss 2025 tax rate, set public hearing date, and authorize notice of public hearing regarding adoption of tax rate; and
    - ii. adopt Resolution Voting for Board of Directors Election for Fort Bend Central Appraisal District.
  - e. Receive quarterly report from Revenue Management Services regarding Strategic Partnership Agreement and take appropriate action.

- f. Review notice of fire protection fee increase from the City of Richmond and, if appropriate, amend the District's Rate Order.
- g. Operation of District facilities, including:
  - i. billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, and message language on water bill;
  - ii. update on manhole and valve repairs;
  - iii. update on installation of smart meters;
  - iv. review and, if appropriate, approve Second Amendment to Professional Service Contract; and
  - v. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
- h. Engineering matters, including:
  - iii. design, plan approval, advertisement for bids, contract award, and pay estimates for District projects, including:
    - aa. replacement of fences at District facilities;
    - bb. Water Supply System;
    - cc. cleaning and televising of sanitary sewer lines;
    - dd. water plant no. 2;
    - ee. sanitary sewer force main headers upgrade;
    - ff. Crabb River Road water line loop;
    - gg. sanitary sewer lift station no. 5 and force main along FM 762; and
    - hh. sanitary sewer system improvements;
  - iv. City of Richmond Wastewater Treatment Plant;
  - v. developer items;
  - vi. update on bond application no. 12;
  - vii. GIS system; and
  - viii. deeds, easements, plats, consents to encroachment, requests for service, utility commitment letters, wastewater services contracts, and plan approvals.
- i. Review and, if appropriate, amend the District's Groundwater Reduction Plan Participation Agreement with the City of Richmond.
- j. Annexation matters, including:
  - i. updates on pending annexations and take appropriate action;
  - ii. consider request for temporary out-of-District service and take appropriate action; and
  - iii. review the District's Annexation Guidelines and consider modifications to same.

- k. Park and recreational facility matters, including:
  - i. District trail system, including consider land ownership/conveyance matters and take appropriate action; and
  - ii. update on Fort Bend County proposed trail system.
- l. District website and communication matters, consider proposals, and take appropriate action.
- m. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.072, Texas Government Code, to deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property.
- n. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property.
